Early Start

What is Early Start all about?

- The Early Start program provides an opportunity for children to further develop and practise some skills necessary for school. Language, fine and gross motor skills, literacy, and numeracy readiness are the focus of the program. Children will participate in activities to assist their readiness to start formal work at the beginning of their Prep year.
- The Early Start program is designed to make sure your child is fully supported in their transition between kinder and primary school. We aim to have your child feeling safe and secure in the school environment before they begin school. The additional school readiness skills taught in early start will ensure that they are off to a flying start at school.
- Early Start is also designed to be a supportive transition for families of students. Staff will be available to discuss any details about the school, the school programs and what we can do to provide for your child's needs.

When will it operate?

We will run our sessions on Wednesdays for 2 hours. Times will be from 9:00am until 11am.

When will it start?

Our program will begin in Term 4 on the 4th of November, and we'll finish on the statewide transition day held on Tuesday the 9th of December.

Who can come?

Any students who are intending to attend prep at Tanjil South Primary School in the following school year may attend the program.

What will it cost?

There is no cost for students to attend the program. We do ask that children bring their own water bottle, a piece of fruit, and a small healthy snack.

Where will it be held?

The program will make use of all our school facilities including the classroom, multipurpose room and playground.

Who will be taking the program?

Our programme is facilitated by highly experienced staff. All Tanjil South Primary school staff and current students will have opportunities throughout the program to build positive relationships with our pre-prep students.

What do I need to do?

Complete the Application to Enrol form or the school enrolment form and return it to the school by the 25th of October. School tours are available by contacting the office and making an appointment.
